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Introduction - Dennis Janzen, Ph.D. has had an extensive and highly successful career as a volleyball coach and educator internationally and within the United States. He is the founder of Paragon Coaching Resources and Paragon Sports Performance Consulting. Both entities provide high performance education resources and mental training services for coaches and athletes.

Janzen has worked in a variety of coaching roles, serving most recently as the Head Coach for the Men's and Women's National Teams of Singapore. The Singapore position focused on re-establishing the national team programs which had been largely in-active for the previous several years. Janzen has significant experience with USA Volleyball including 1991 (Assistant Men's) and 1995 Head Men's coaching positions at the US Olympic Festivals. He served as an assistant coach with the Men's National Team in 1992. Janzen recently has served as a head coach for three different USA Women's Collegiate National Teams (2016, 2017, and 2018). Collegiately, Janzen was an assistant men's coach for Penn State University (NCAA 3rd place), and University of Southern California (NCAA Nationally ranked #1). Janzen was the Head Women's Coach for 25 years at Fresno Pacific University (1983-91 – 1994-2010) building one of the most successful university volleyball programs in the nation at any level. Janzen has served as a consultant volleyball coach for Canadian power Trinity Western University (2014 – 2018) and NCAA Div. II power Western Washington University (2013). Janzen also has a long history of involvement with the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) including serving for many years on the Education/Publications Committee. He has been a frequent speaker/presenter at major clinics and conferences both in the U.S. and internationally. From 2004 – 2013 Janzen served as the Director of Athletics at Fresno Pacific and from 1995 – 2004, served as FPU's first Director of Athletic Development. Janzen has been inducted into the NAIA Coaches Hall of Fame, the Fresno Pacific University Athletics Hall of Fame, and twice (individual and team honors) into the prestigious Fresno County Sports Hall of Fame, a Sports Hall of Fame that ranks in the top 3% of Sports Halls of Fame in the nation.

Recent Volleyball Experiences – Head Men's and Women's Volleyball Coach – Singapore National Teams – Dr. Janzen was the Head Men's and Women's National Team Head Coach for Singapore from late July, 2018 until December, 2019. The goal and purpose was two-fold: 1) to re-establish and re-build the Singapore Indoor National Teams to respectability within the Asian Volleyball Confederation (FIVB Zone) and Southeast Asian (ASEAN) volleyball world, and 2) to update and re-write the CoachSG and Volleyball Association of Singapore coach education materials that lead to a National Registry of Coaching (NROC) certification. Previous Singapore coach

education materials had not been updated for over 15 years. Coach Education materials, approved by CoachSG for National Registry of Coaching (NROC) were successfully re-written and updated for the Level 1 Integrated Volleyball Course, with the Level 2 Integrated Volleyball Course currently being developed and written. On court competition highlights included the qualification of the Men's National Team for the Southeast Asia Games (SEA Games)! The SEA Games qualification marked the first time in over 20 years any indoor volleyball national team has qualified via winning for the SEA Games (Both national teams participated in the 2015 SEA Games via a host bid).

USA Women's Collegiate National Team – Head Coach - Janzen worked with USA Volleyball as an evaluator for the USA Women's National Team Program. For the summers of 2016, 2017, and 2018 he served as a Head Coach for the USA Collegiate Women's National Team, a primary developmental pipeline for the USA Women's Senior National and Olympic Teams. The 2016 team finished second in the final competition with both the 2017 and 2018 teams winning the final training camp exhibition competitions!

Former Head Women's Volleyball Coach - Formerly the head women's volleyball coach at FPU from 1983-1991, then 1994-2010, Janzen was the winningest women's coach in all of U.S. college volleyball from 2001-2010 with a 373-18 win-loss record. With an overall career win-loss of 867-168, Janzen's team's also attained win streaks of 121 consecutive home-court victories and 91 straight regular season wins. Winning a total of six national championships, Janzen's teams had an NAIA record 20 national tournament appearances and appeared for 184 consecutive weeks in the NAIA national "top five" poll. This streak of national rankings included 43 straight weeks ranked #1 nationally and a total of 70 weeks overall. FPU volleyball also achieved a graduation rate of nearly 96%. A four-time National Coach of the Year, Janzen has been inducted four times into various Athletics Halls of Fame. He also had coaching stints as an assistant men's coach with the U.S.A. National Team, Penn State University and the Univ. of Southern California. In 2014-15, Janzen assisted at Western Washington University helping lead the Vikings to an NCAA Tournament berth and a top 10 national ranking. Janzen also advised the Trinity Western University women's volleyball team (2014-15), where they won their first-ever Canadian university national championship. From 2015-18 he served as a consultant and member of the Trinity Western coaching staff. Janzen recently served the Volleyball Association of Singapore (VAS) as the new head coach for the Singapore Men's and Women's National Teams. An additional emphasis with the VAS was to work with Sport Singapore to develop volleyball-specific coach education resources for all coaches and teachers in Singapore.

Former Director of Athletics – As FPU's Director of Athletics from 2004-2013, Janzen lead a Department of Athletics program that resulted in significant competitive upgrades and growth in programs as well as facilities. Known as a highly effective fundraiser and program builder, Janzen oversaw the development of new facilities for baseball, tennis, and track-soccer along with the major expansion of the Sports Medicine facilities. A cooperative effort with FPU Kinesiology, Student Life, and Athletics resulted in a major upgrade and expansion of a University Fitness Center. Janzen also introduced new sport programs for baseball, men's and women's swimming, water polo, and tennis. Recent tentative approval for the addition of the softball program also occurred under Janzen's watch. Indicative of this growth was the improvement in national finish in the annual Learfield Sports Director's Cup standings. In 2004 when Janzen became the Director of Athletics, FPU had not finished higher than 75th. From 2008 through 2012 until when FPU entered the NCAA membership transition period, FPU's Learfield Sports Director's Cup finishes ranged from 3rd to 6th nationally out of over 300 other university athletics programs. Most FPU teams were annually listed in their

respective national poll. National championships in women's volleyball, men's and women's tennis, and men's and women's swimming as well as elite national finishes in men's basketball, men's soccer, and a College World Series berth for baseball are just some of the highlights that occurred under Janzen's watch. Numerous individual national champions along with All Americans have emerged from the water polo, swimming, and track & field programs. Professional athletes in several sports have come from FPU. While serving as the Director of Athletics, Janzen stated, "Our athletics program has earned a strong reputation of one that is extremely competitive, has high standards for performance, behavior, and integrity in the classroom and in competition, and provides a collegiate athletics experience that the University, its constituency, and alumni are very proud of." Janzen was the 2009 Golden State Athletics Conference Athletics Director of the Year.

Academic Experience - Dennis Janzen holds a Ph.D. in the Psychology of Sport and was a full professor at Fresno Pacific University in the School of Natural Sciences. Recently retired, Dr. Janzen has taught both undergraduate and graduate Psychology of Sport. Dr. Janzen continues to teach as an adjunct professor as needed. He has also taught graduate courses in Personal Leadership, History and Philosophy of Kinesiology, Sport Sales and Sponsorship, and Sport Leadership and Administration. Privately, he provides high performance education services for coaches and athletics administrators in the areas of elite mental performance, team building, character education and culture, leadership development, and restorative discipline.
